In response to your question about Lane County's eligibility, here is the answer:

This opportunity is available for any peer-run organization operating in Oregon. The geographical restriction refers to where the peer-respite programs are to be physically located, and does not refer to where the organization operating the program is headquartered. So a peer-run org based in Lane county could in theory operate a program in any of those areas if they wished.

Also, Lane county is inclusive of coastal communities, which is one of the identified locations for a program.

Oregon To Create Peer-Run Mental Health Respite Programs

On September 15, 2022, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued a request for grant proposals (RFGA OHA-S-44300-00004104) seeking four peer-run mental health respite programs. Proposals are due by October 27, 2022. The respite programs will be located in the Portland-Metro area, central or eastern Oregon, southern Oregon and the Oregon coast. The state intends to distribute \$6 million in grants, in the amount of \$750,000 per program.

The peer-run mental health respite program was established under Oregon House Bill 2980, which was signed on July 27, 2021. The legislation defined a peer respite center as a home-like setting that provides up to two weeks of voluntary, non-clinical continuous residential respite services in a home-like setting for no more than six individuals at a time. The services are for people with mental illness or trauma response symptoms who are experiencing acute distress, anxiety, or emotional pain that may lead to the need for a higher level of care such as psychiatric inpatient hospital services. At least one of the peer respite centers will participate in a pilot project designed specifically to provide culturally responsive services to historically underrepresented communities.

The centers must be run by a peer-services organization. The state defines a peer services organization as an entity in which a majority of those overseeing the organization's operation or who are in a position of control have received mental health services. A peer-run organization must be fully independent, separate, and autonomous from other mental health provider organizations, and must also have the authority and responsibility for all oversight and decision-making on governance, financial, personnel, policy, and program issues in the organization.

The non-clinical services to be provided by the peer-run respite programs include helping the person address financial problems and other issues affecting the social determinants of health. The peer organization will help the current or former consumers of mental health treatment manage trauma using natural supports and can assist with crisis management and coping with potential crisis situations.

Hi Emma,

Bay Area Enterprises' proposal, as submitted, does not demonstrate that it meets the statutory definition of "peer-run organization (PRO)." According to statute, a PRO is defined in part as an organization "In which a majority of individuals who oversee the organization's operation and who are in positions of control have received mental health services..."

BAE's application makes two statements regarding the lived experiences of staff and members of leadership. First, that there are "staff member that have disabilities ranging from physical, developmental, psychological, and behavioral as well as having members of the deaf/hard of hearing, blind and those with sensory issues on staff and helping to guide our environment and services."

Later, it goes on to state that "The Bay Area Enterprises Board of Directors is comprised of individuals that are not only community leaders, but are either themselves persons with a disability or have a close family member with a disability."

Neither of these statements demonstrates that the leadership of the organization have lived experience with the receipt of mental health services. Regarding the first statement, "Behavioral and psychological" disabilities can but do not necessarily include mental health. People with any number of challenges might be described in this way. Regarding the second statement, the use of "persons with a disability" is even broader than "psychological and behavioral disability," and again can include many things beyond mental health.

Even if the proposal clearly indicated that the disability experienced by your staff and board members was related to mental health, the statement would not clearly demonstrate that those with disabilities have a majority in terms of oversight and decision making power. The proposal states that the board membership comprises people with disabilities and people who have families members with disabilities, without indicating the proportions of each group. So there is no way to know if those with disabilities (assuming they are mental health consumers) comprise a majority of decision-makers.

The clarifying information provided in response to your email suggests that they may, in fact, meet the statutory definition but since that was not included in their original application we cannot consider it in the review process. I want to add that we would not have required (and do not desire) disclosures regarding specific diagnoses or trauma experiences of the staff and leadership. A statement that the majority of leadership & decision makers have lived experience as mental health consumers would have been sufficient.

Unfortunately, the decision is final but keep looking for more Grant opportunities in the future and if you have any question, make sure to attend any pre-proposal meetings and/or take advantage of submitting questions to the procurement specialist.

Hello and thank you for reaching out regarding this application. I must admit that I found this determination a little bit puzzling, so I wanted to ensure there was not perhaps a mistake in the determination process and this determination was in fact for Bay Area Enterprises? Based on the statute listed for determination there are 3 specific criteria we believe that we do in fact meet these specifications and did fully demonstrate our organization's status as a peer run organization based on ORS 430.275.



I want to examine the three criteria independently as they apply to our application.

C) We hold full internal autonomy and authority to oversee governance, financial, personnel, policy and program issues within the organization by way of being overseen by an appointed Executive Director overseen by a Board of Directors.

B) We operate independently of any mental health agency of any kind.

A) The majority of leaders in positions of authority, and in fact almost all members of our staff have and do receive mental health services. In the application we spoke specifically to staff and leadership having behavioral, and psychological diagnosis. I did not find it specifically appropriate to espouse on specific diagnosis nor did I want to discuss the individual mental health needs and traumas experienced by leadership in order to show we meet this definition. If this is a determining factor and you would allow for the opportunity to clarify our application.

I Emma DeRock, am the Executive Director of this agency. I am diagnosed and treated for ADHD, I struggle every day with maintaining my mental health needs in order to support the mental health needs of my staff and management teams. I don't want to speak further on the specific mental health barriers faced by my staff, more so than to mention again that we have multiple members of leadership that are deaf, living in a world made for hearing individuals has a long and lasting impact on an individual's mental health and psyche. I believe the reason our application may not have read so "mental-health" focused, is because we see the individual in its wholistic form. With comorbidity rates between physical and mental health disorders ranging between 75-90%, we find it impossible to separate out the implications of ones mental and physical deficits and instead our culture is such that we address all needs and limitations as equal.

As I am not sure if this decision if final or not, so I wanted to take the opportunity to ask for a reconsideration and thank you for your time!
