



# Oregon Data extracted from the National Survey on Drug Use and Health, released February 2024

The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) provides national and state-level data on the use of tobacco, alcohol, illicit drugs (including the non-medical use of prescription drugs) and mental health in the United States. Information from NSDUH is used to support prevention and treatment programs, monitor substance use trends, estimate the need for treatment and inform public health policy.





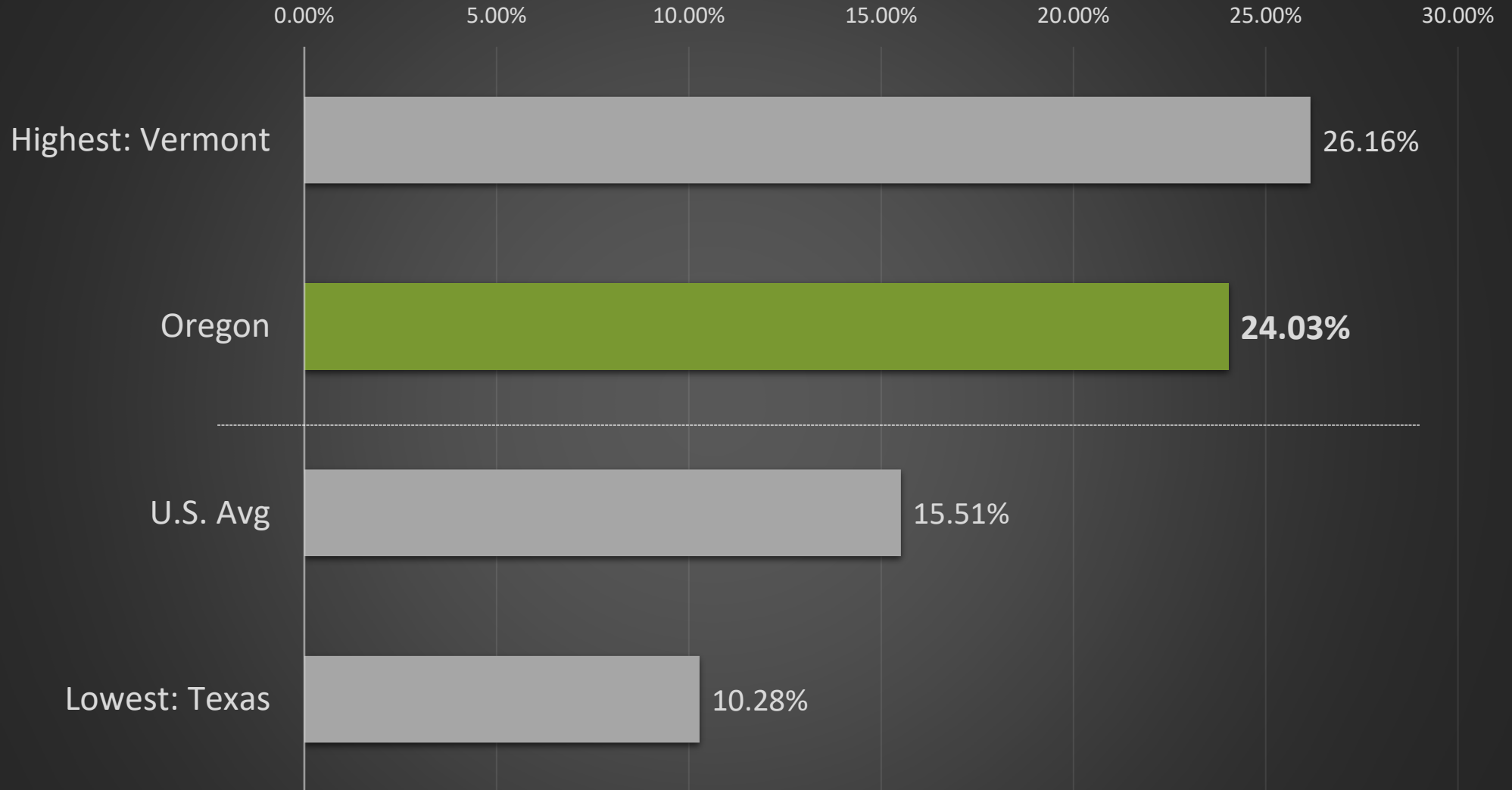
# Illicit Drug Use in the Past Month,

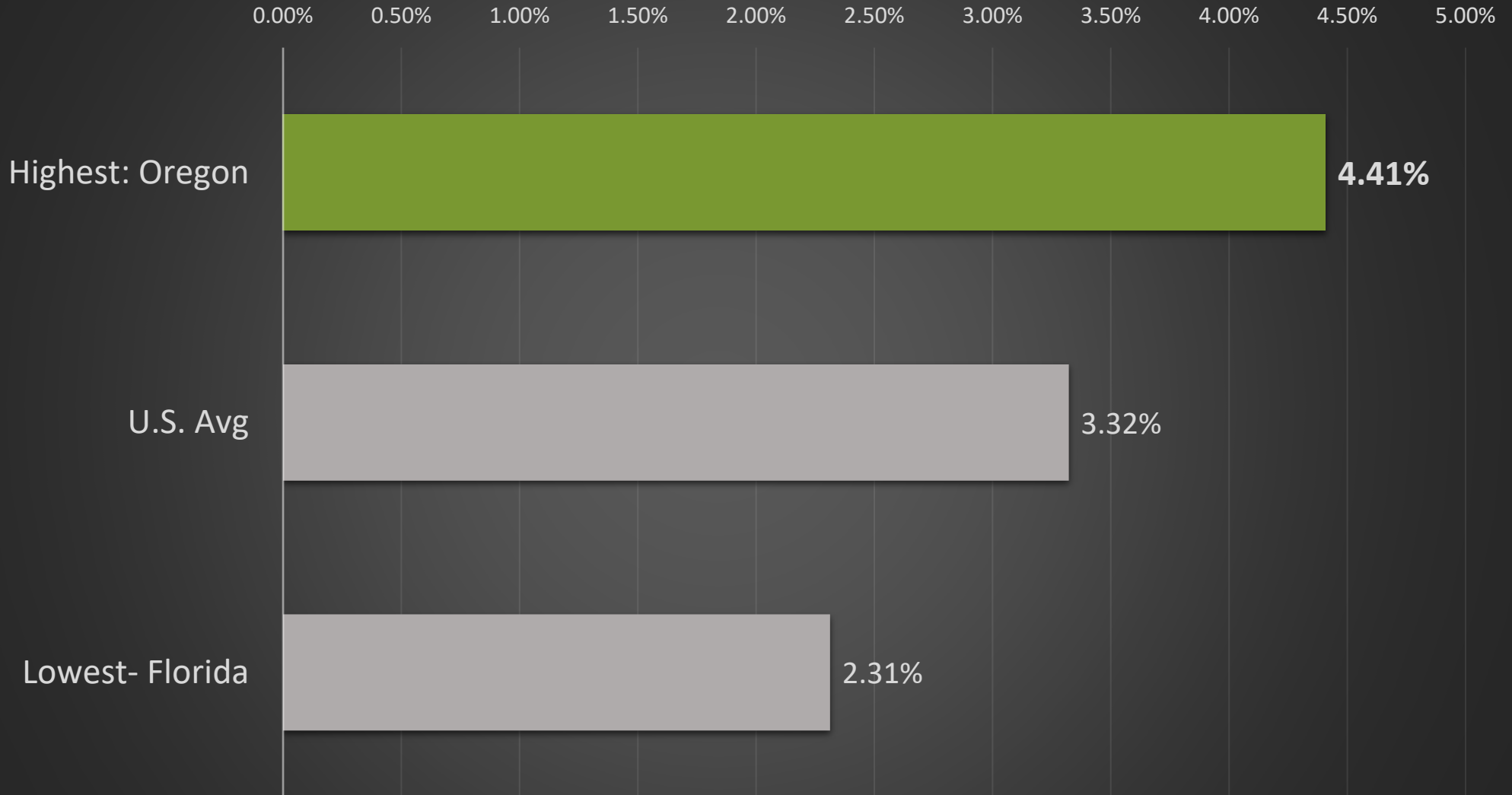

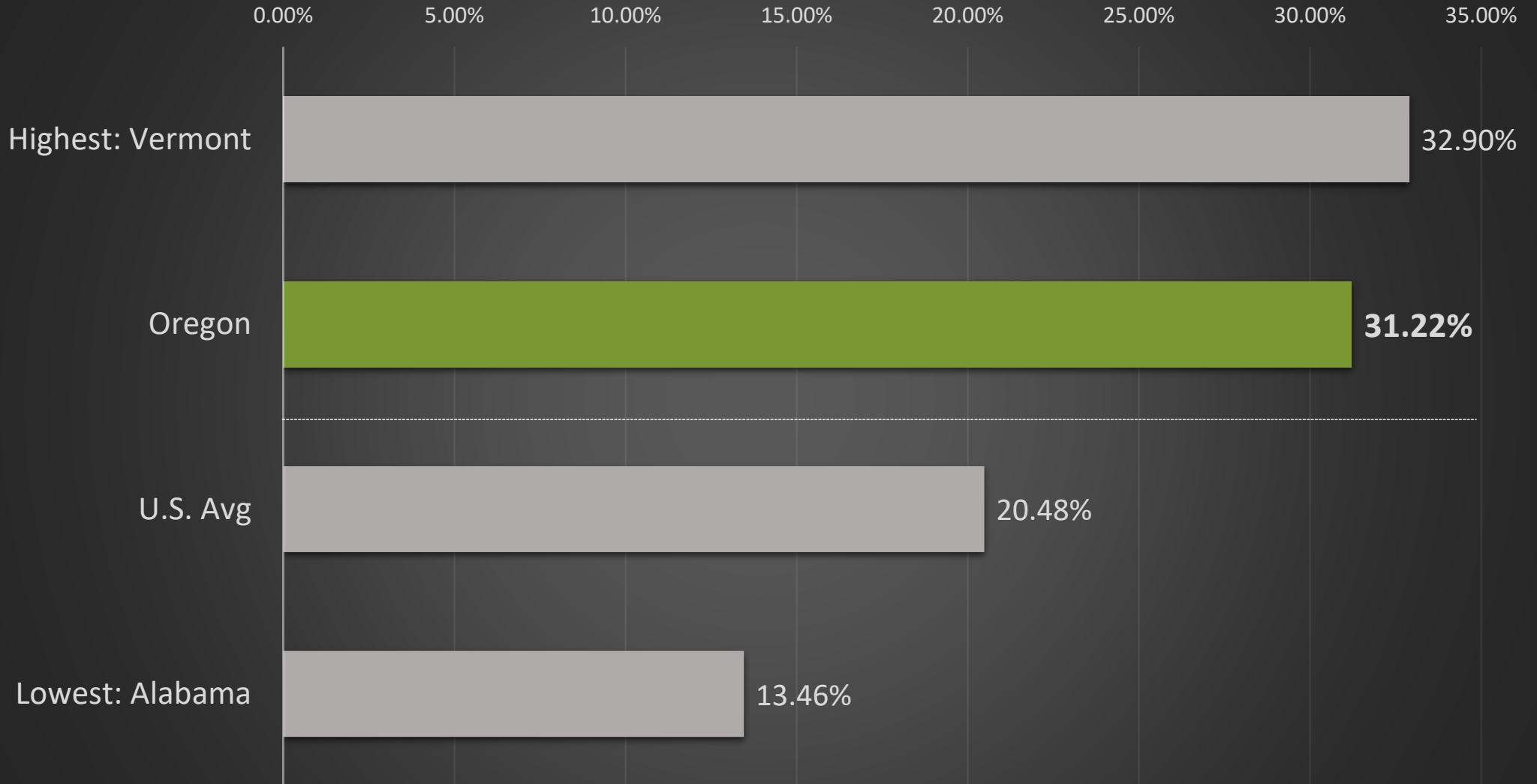

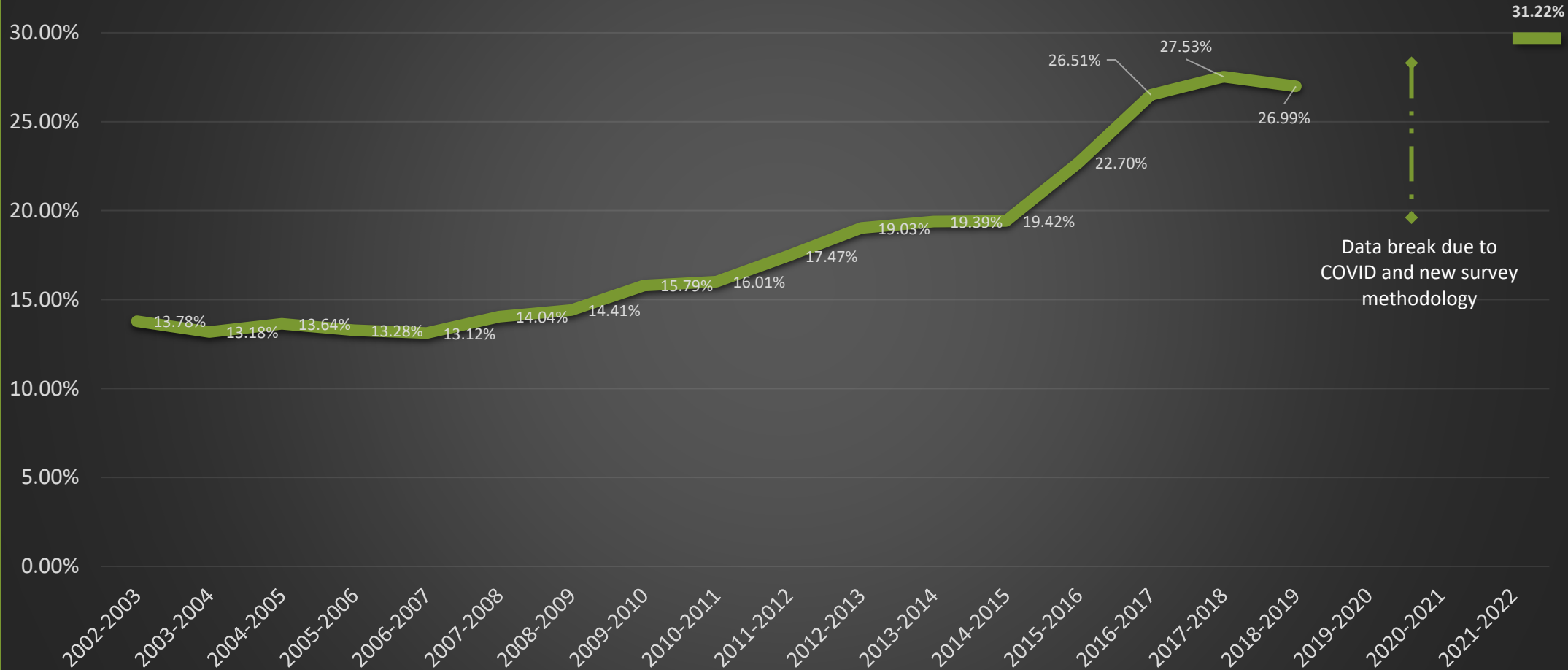

## Past Year Marijuana Use 2002-2022



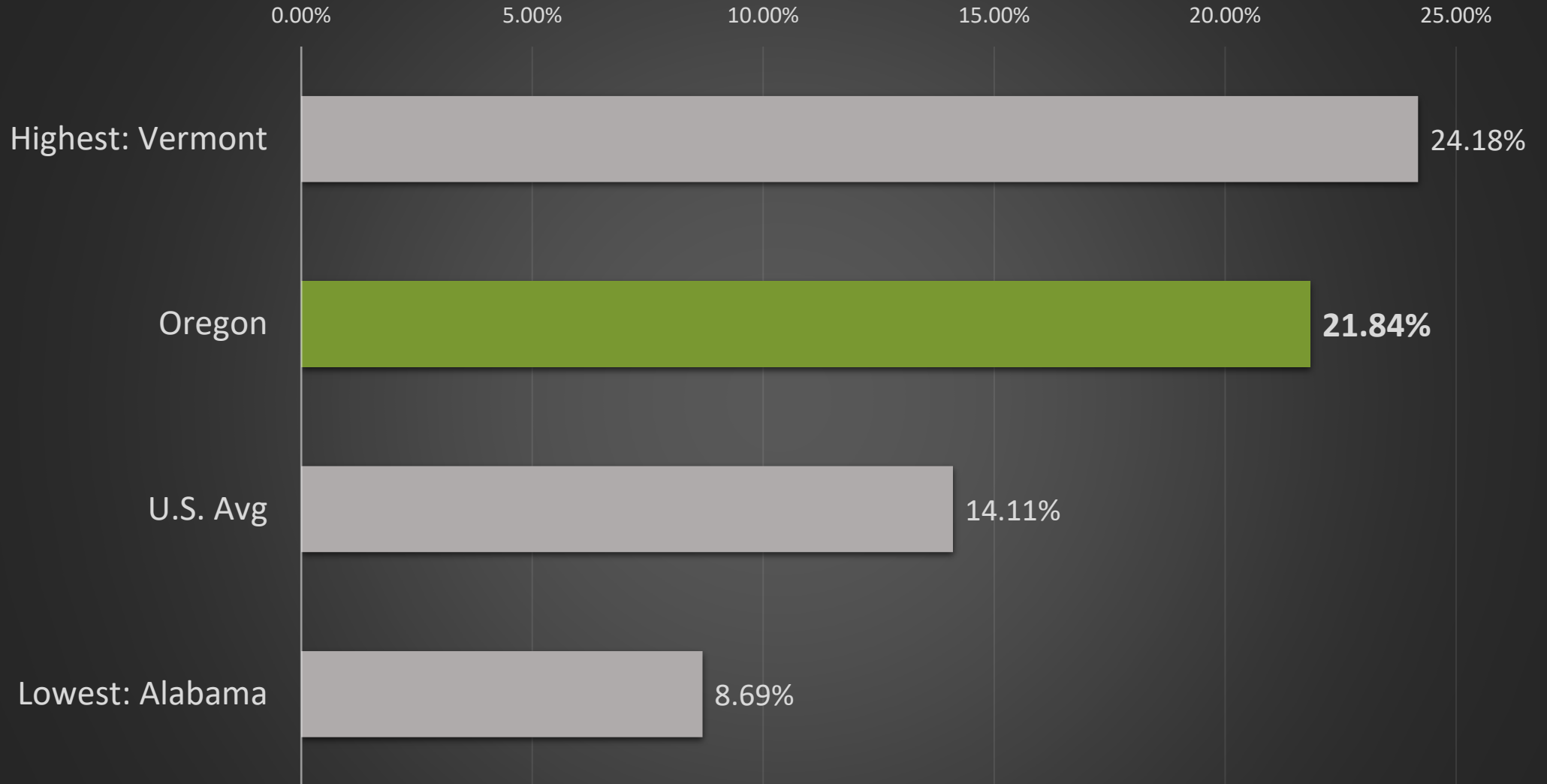

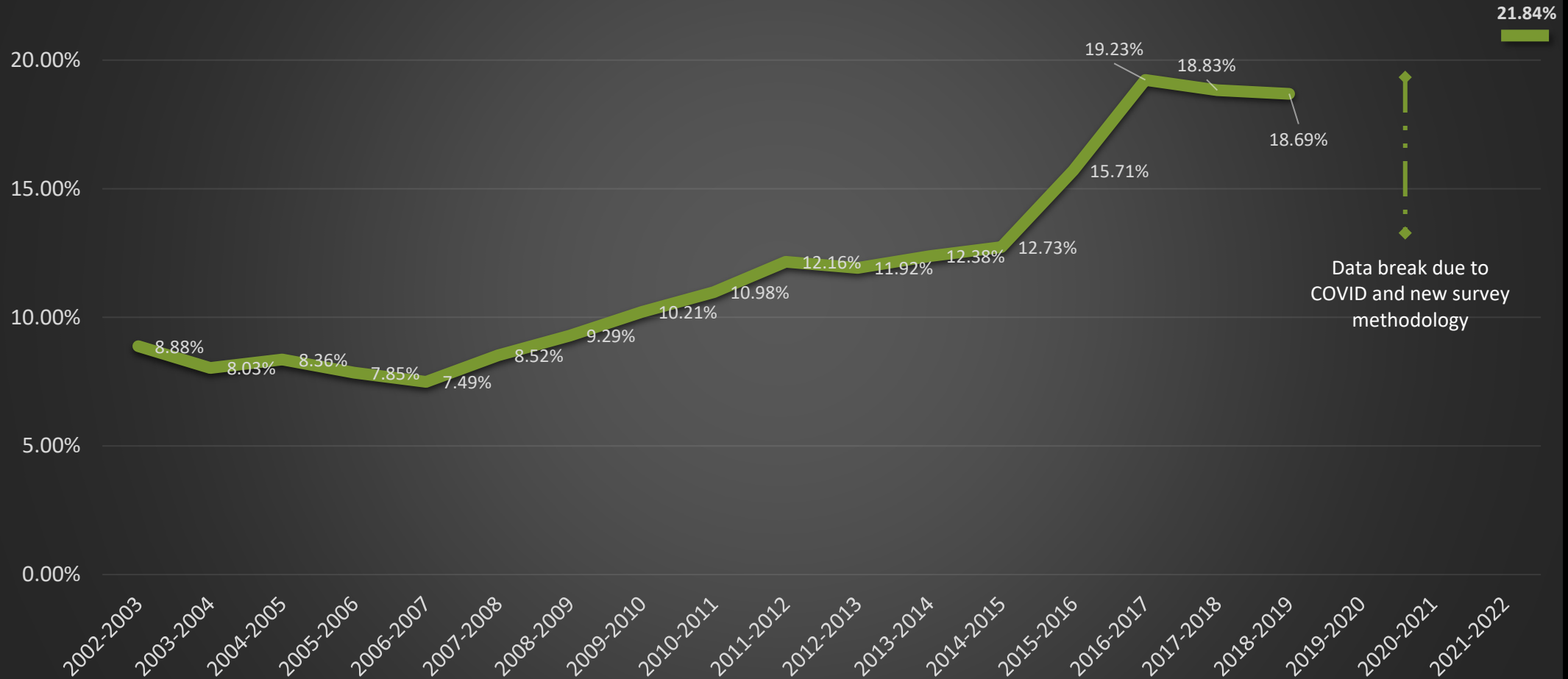

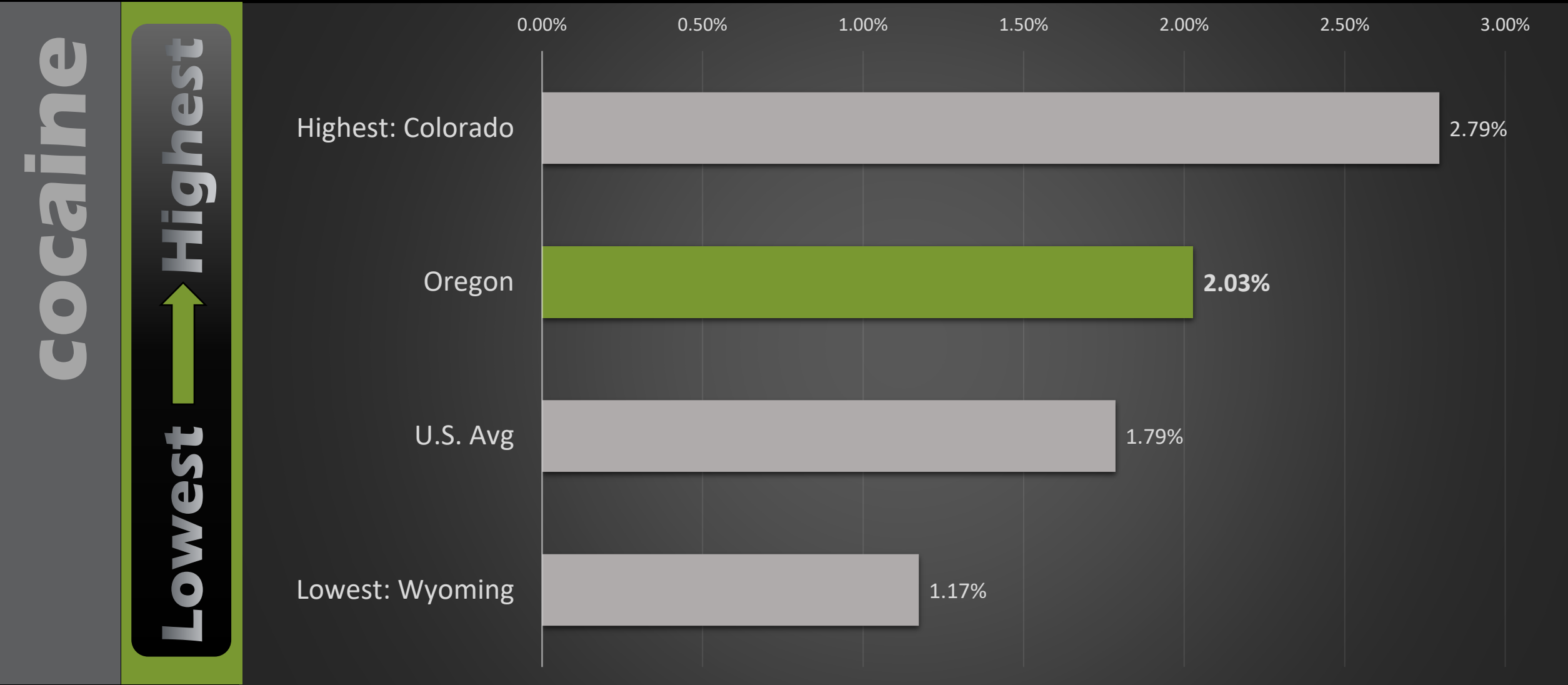

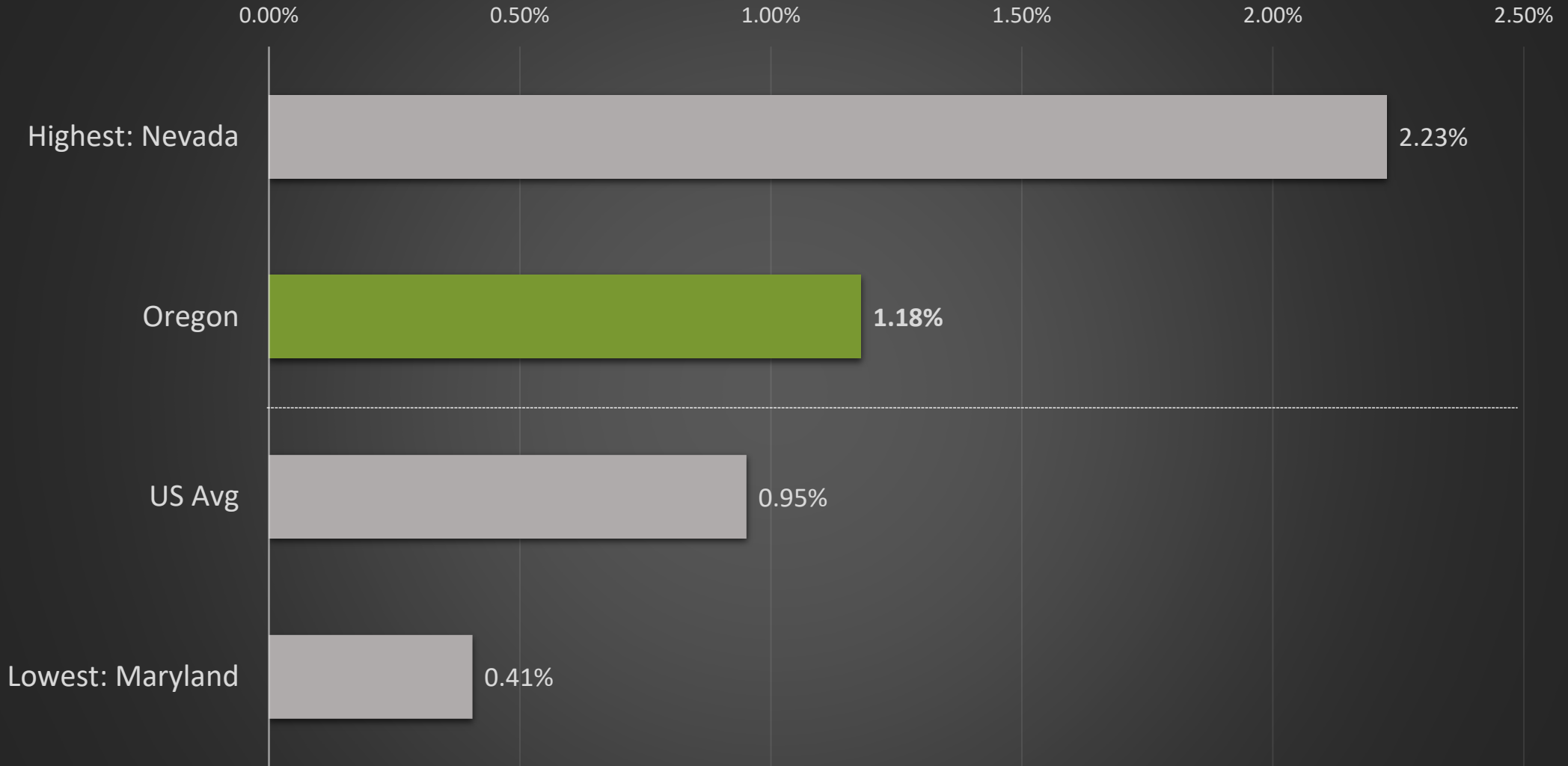

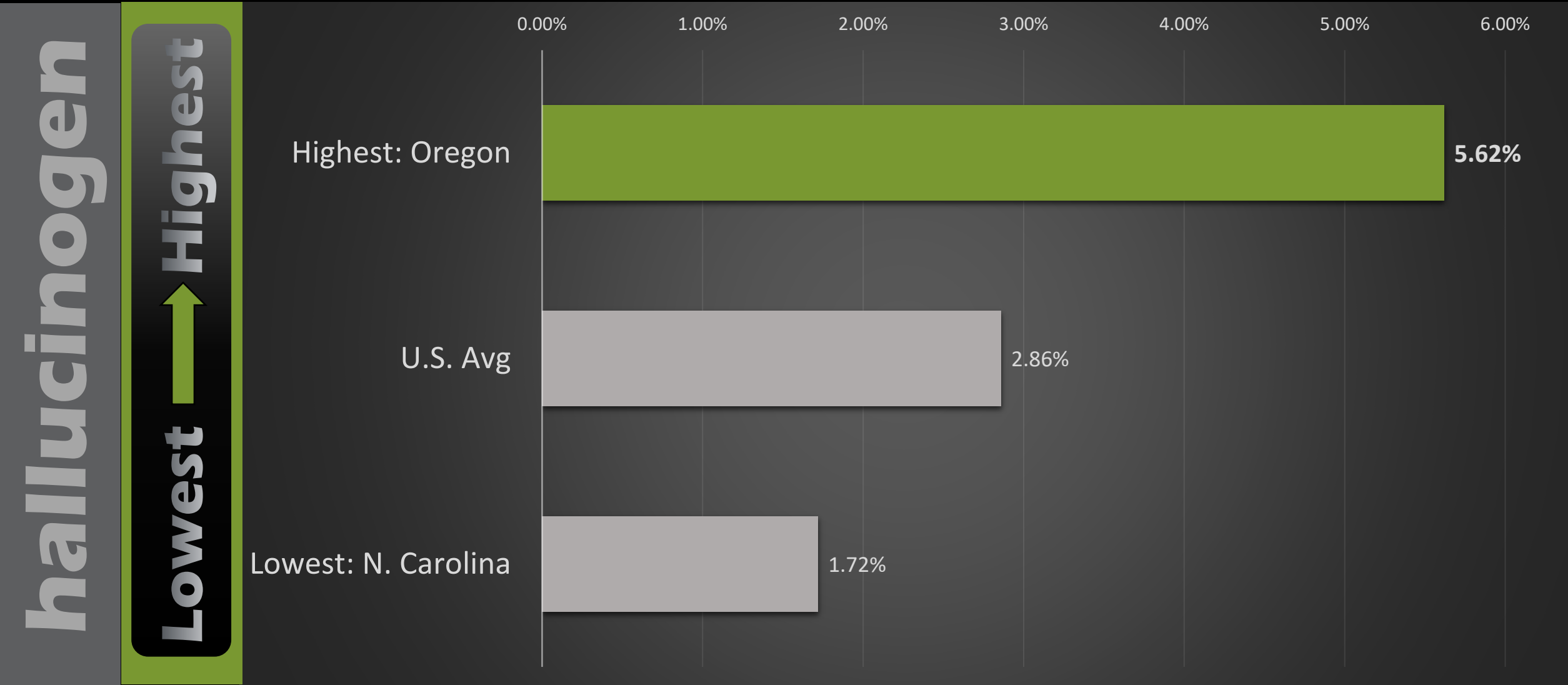

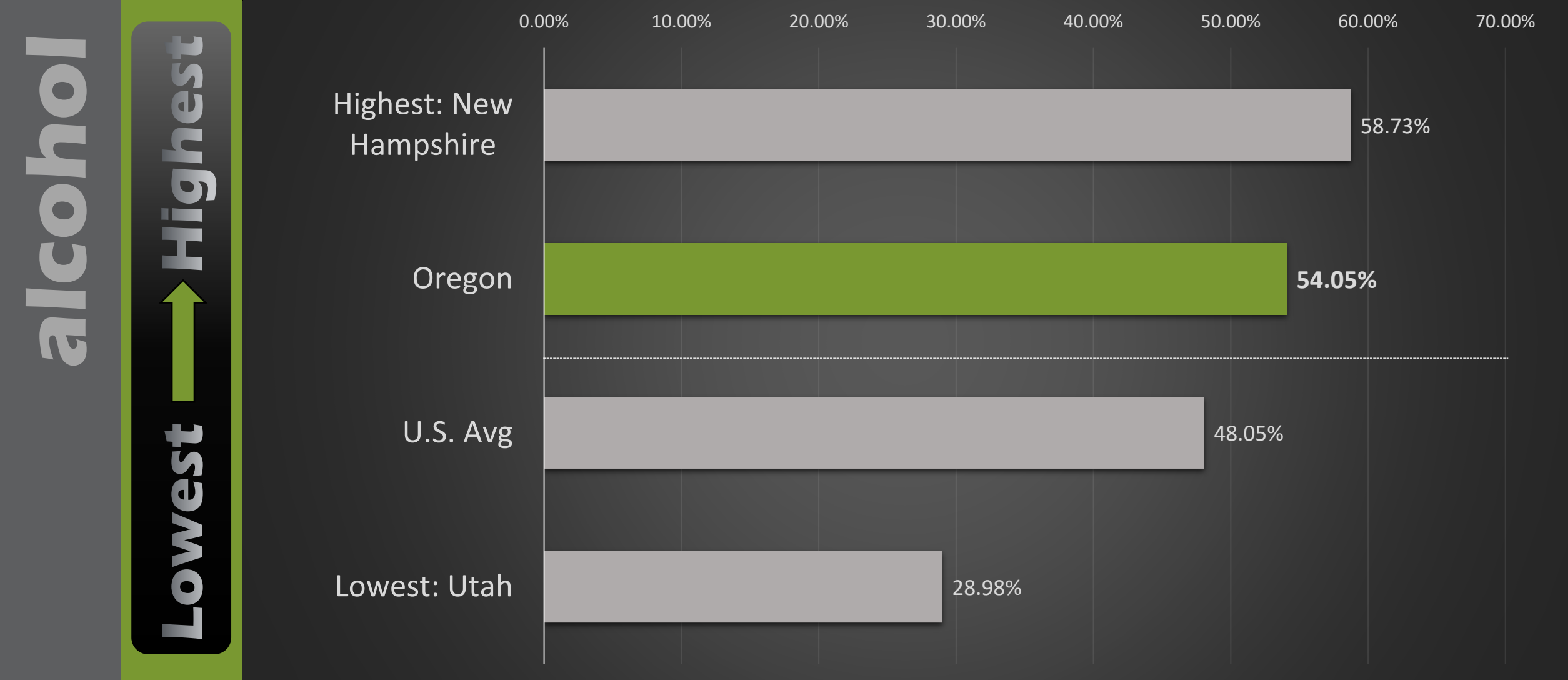

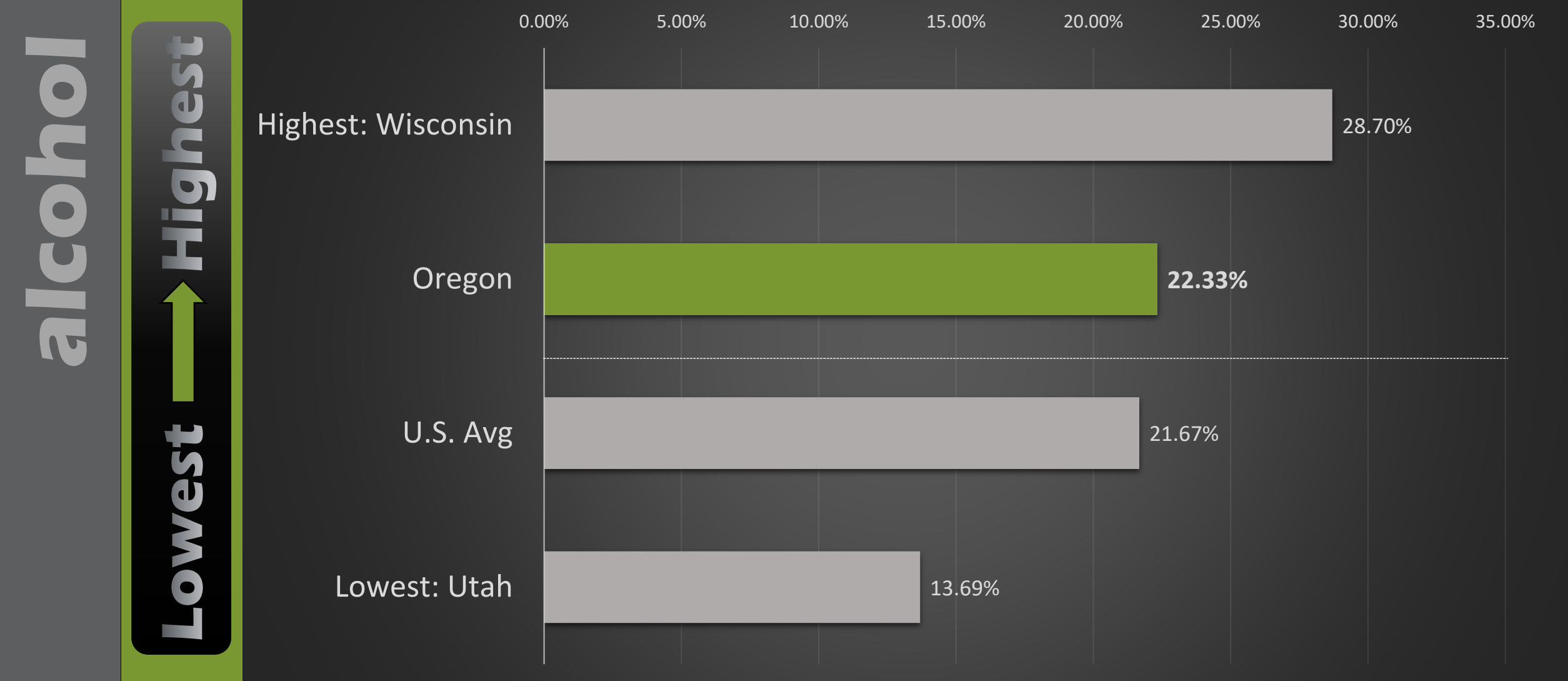

# Binge Alcohol use in the Past Month,

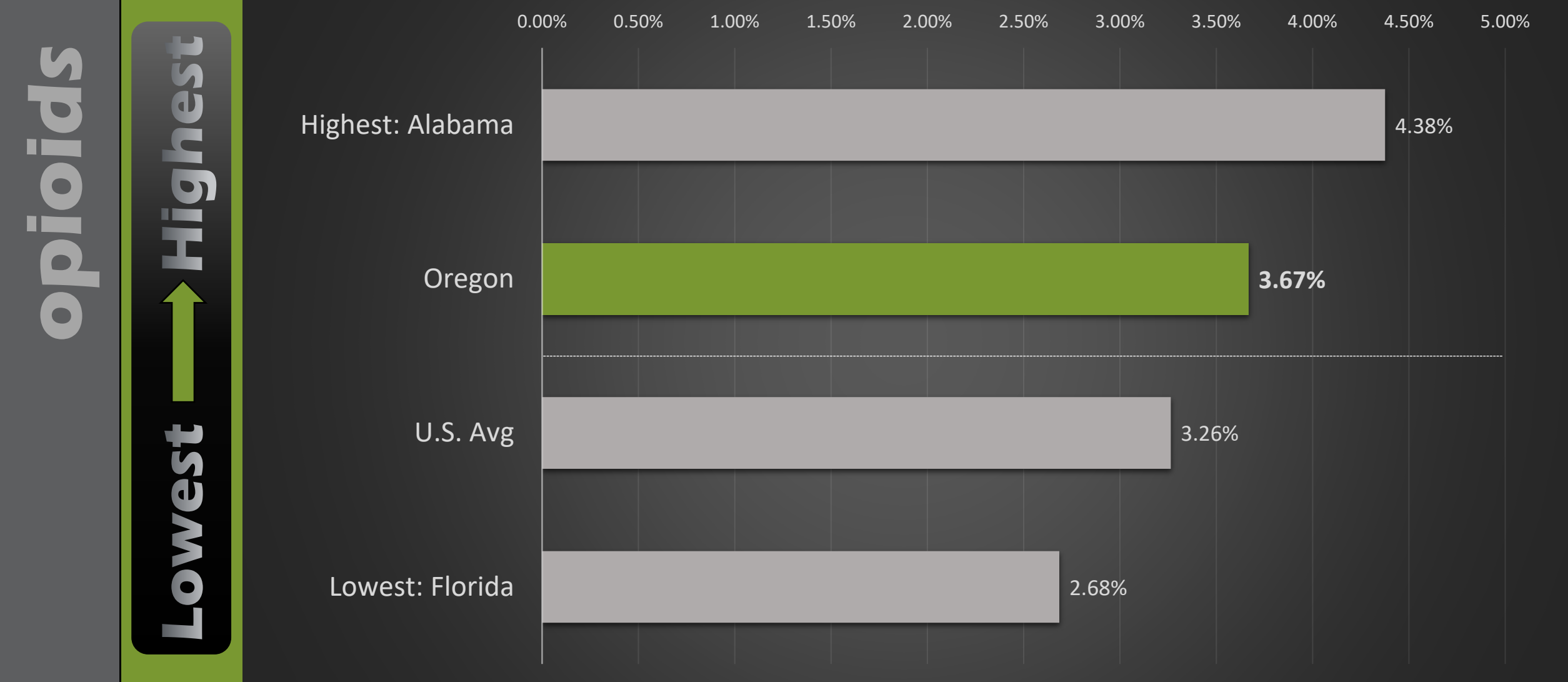

# Opioid Misuse Past Year,

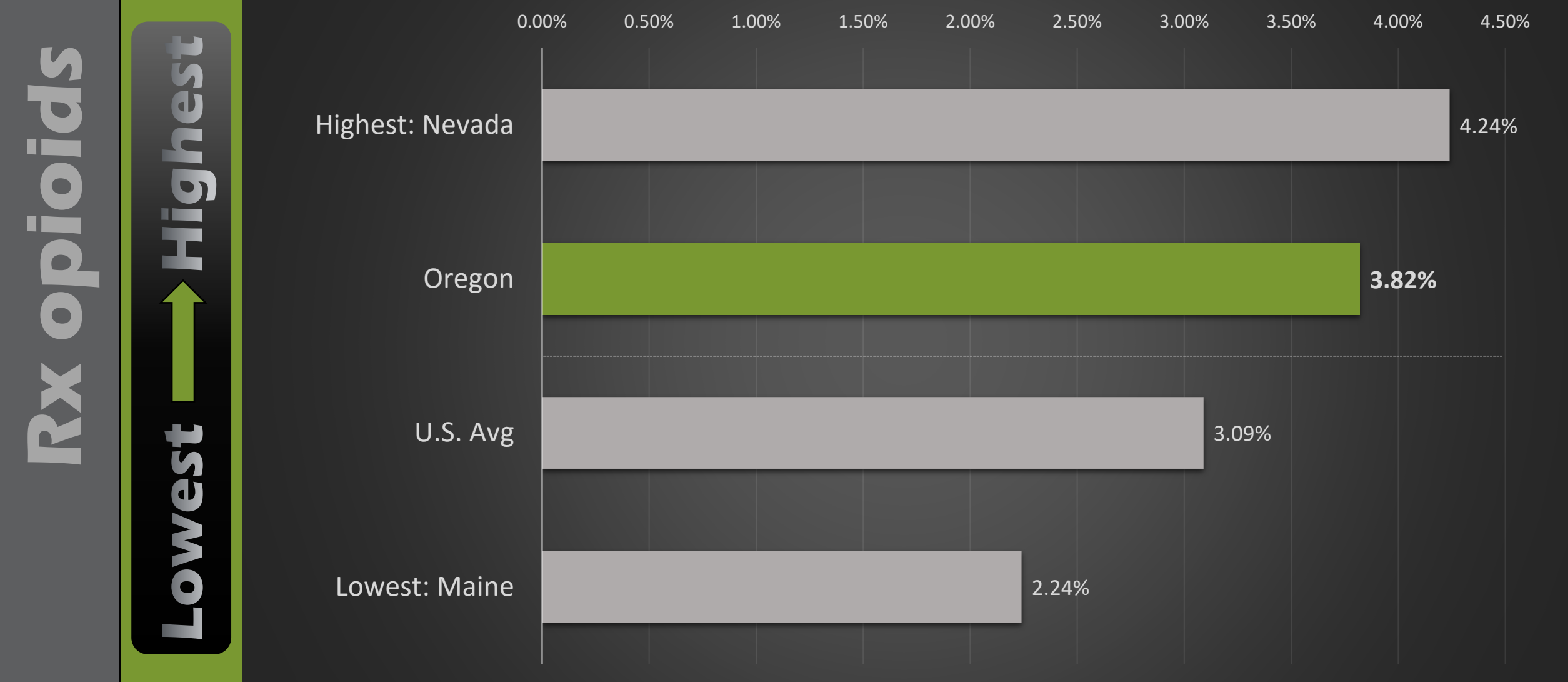

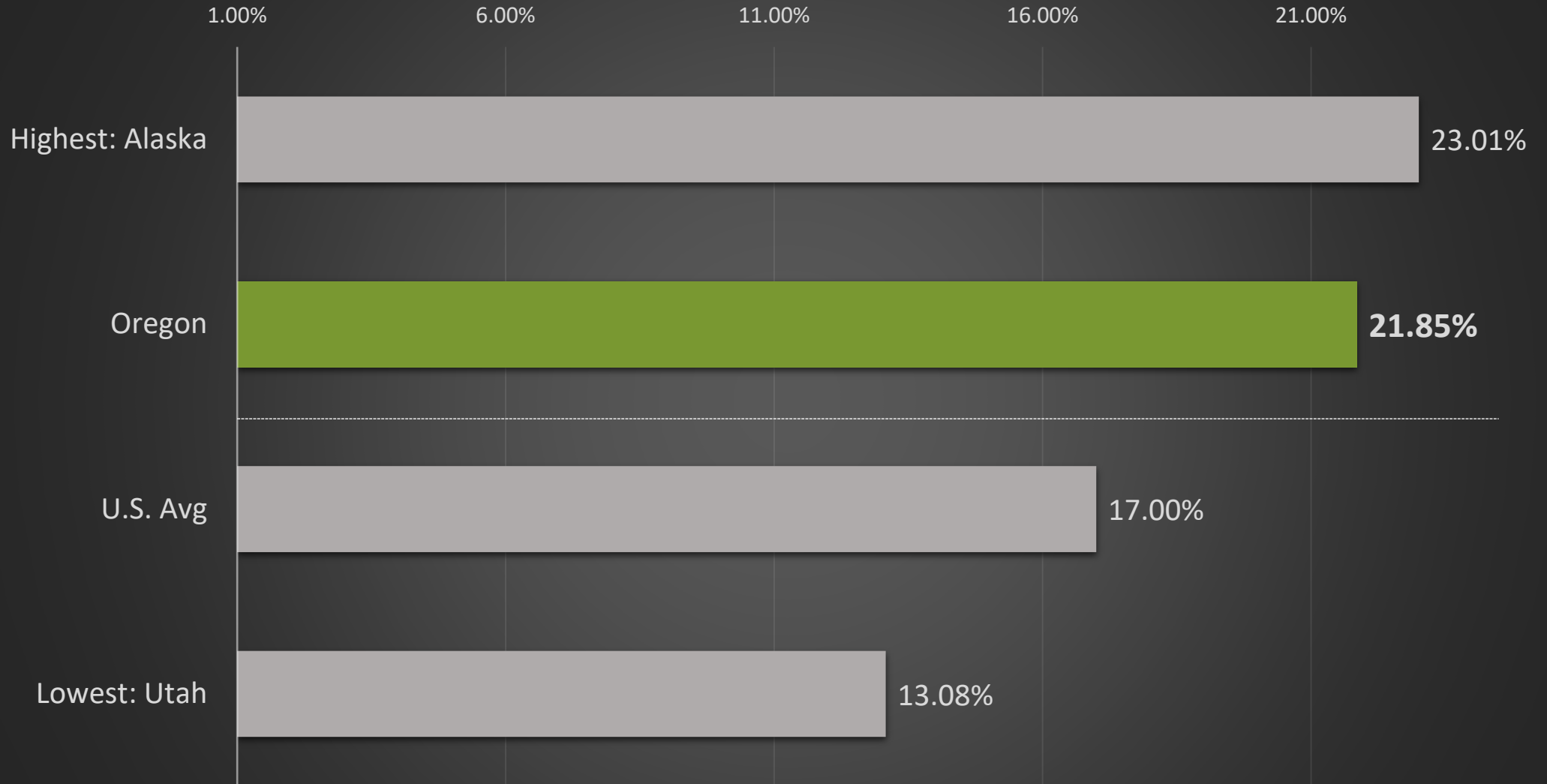


# Substance Use Disorder Past Year,

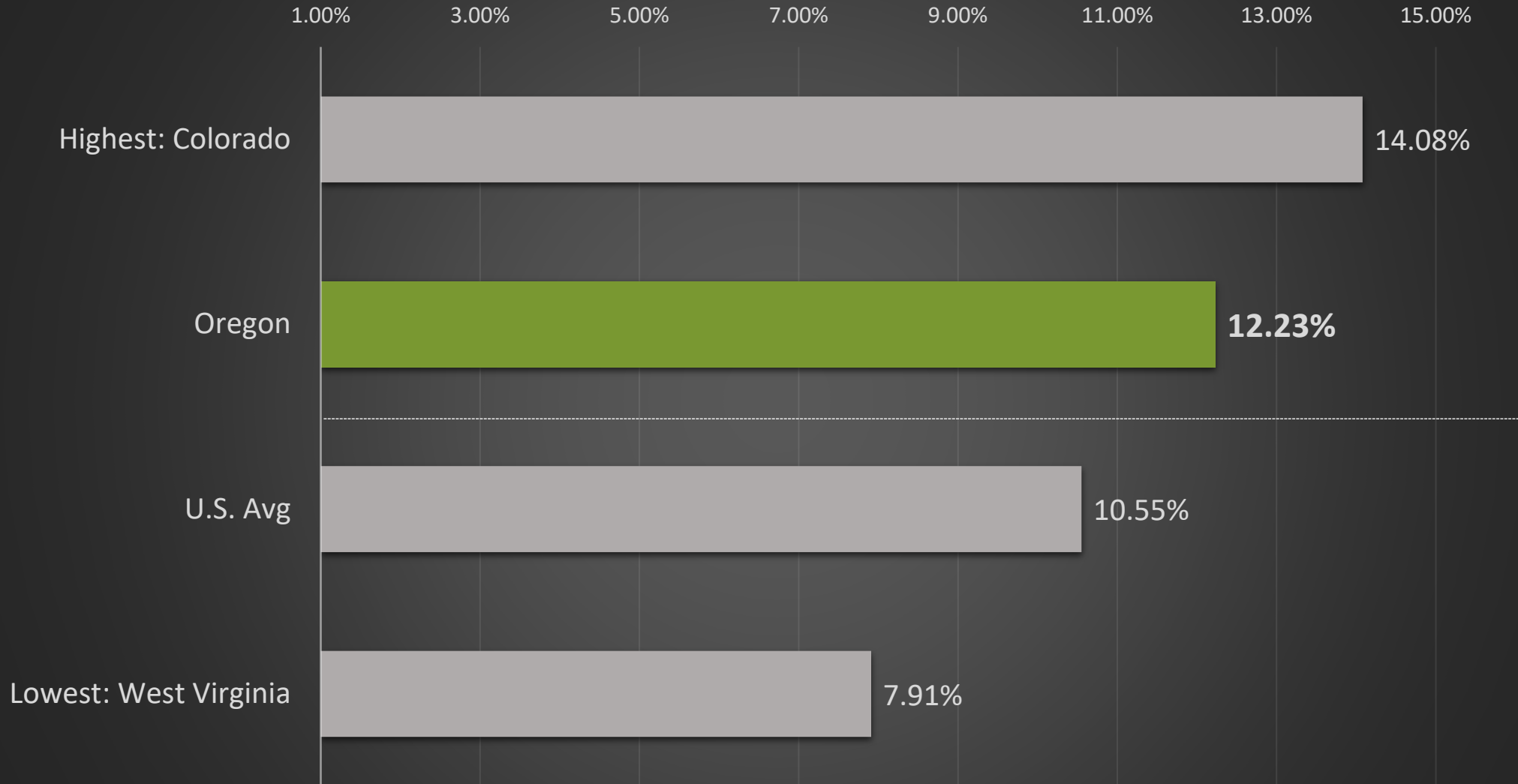


# Alcohol Use Disorder Past Year,

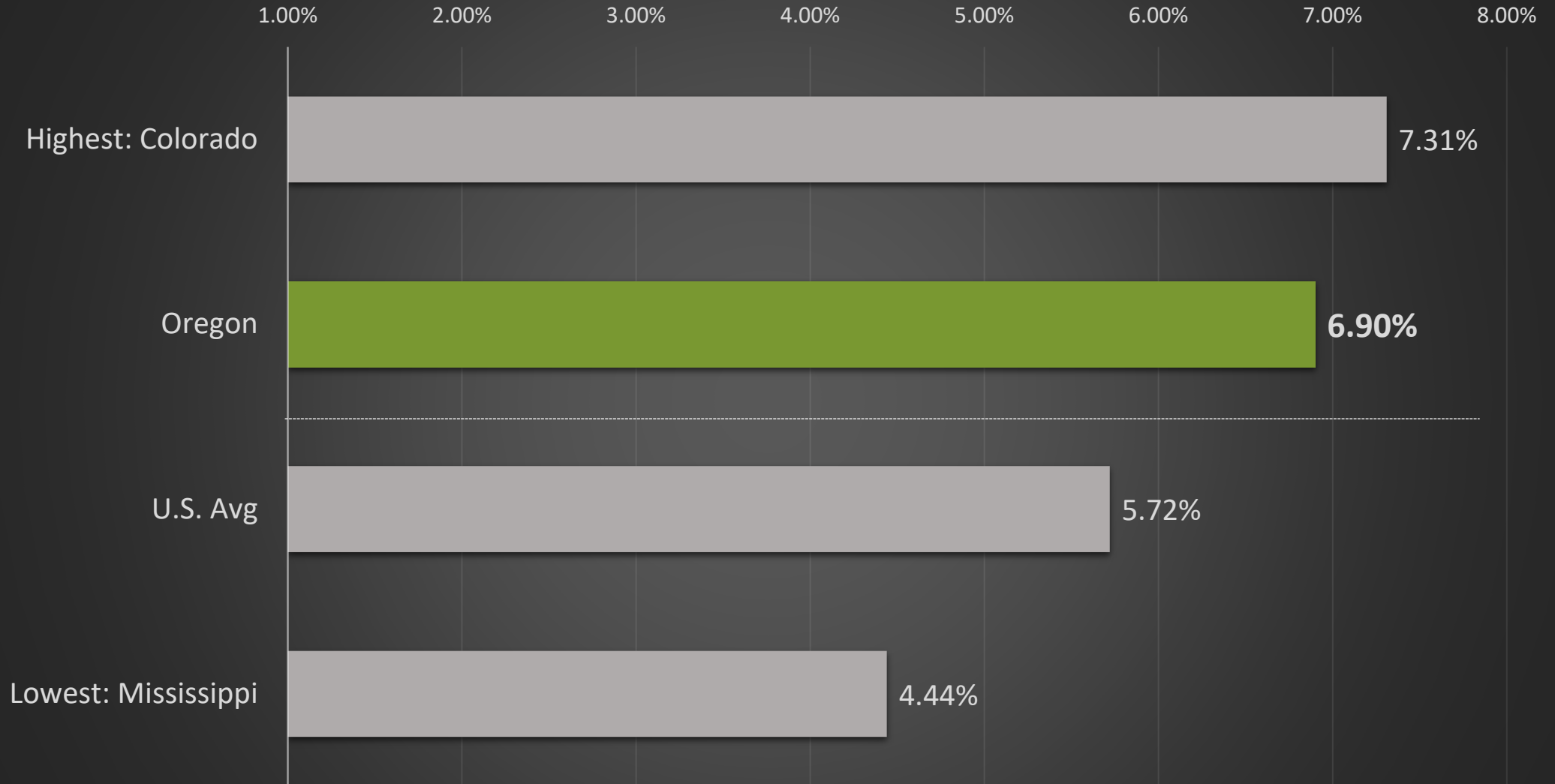


# Alcohol Use Disorder Past Year, Ages 12-20

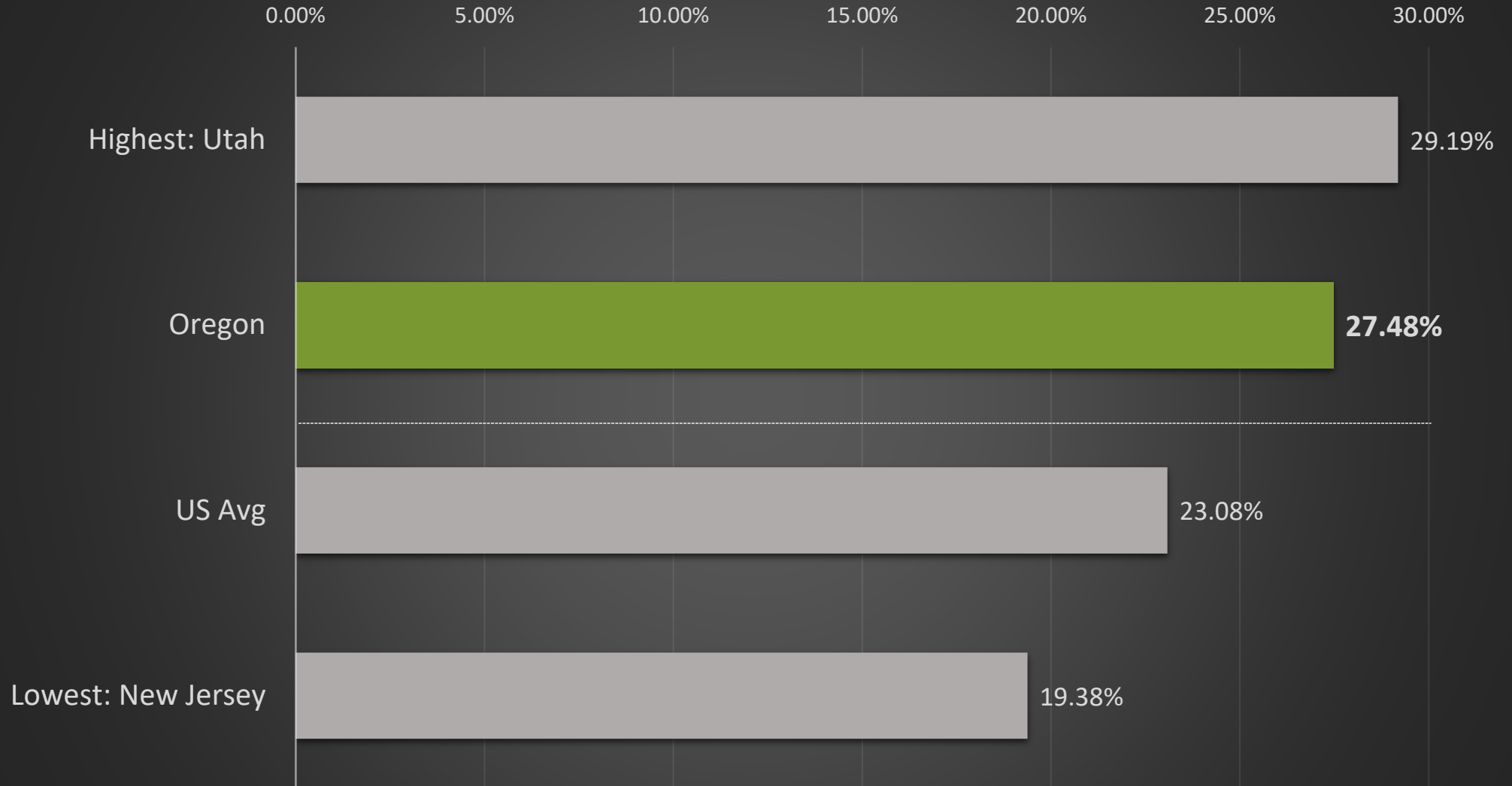


# Any Mental Illness Past Year,

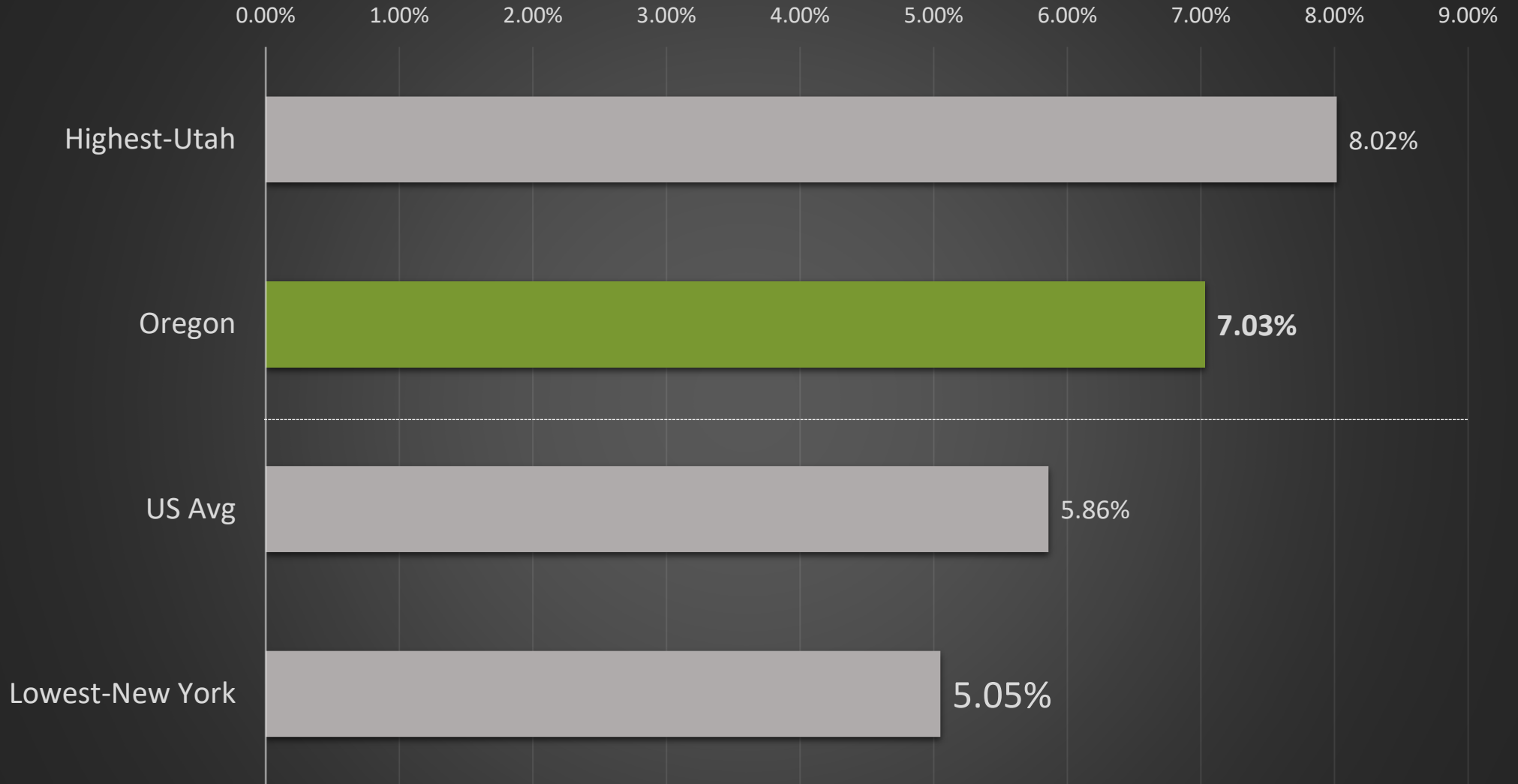


# Serious Mental Illness Past Year,

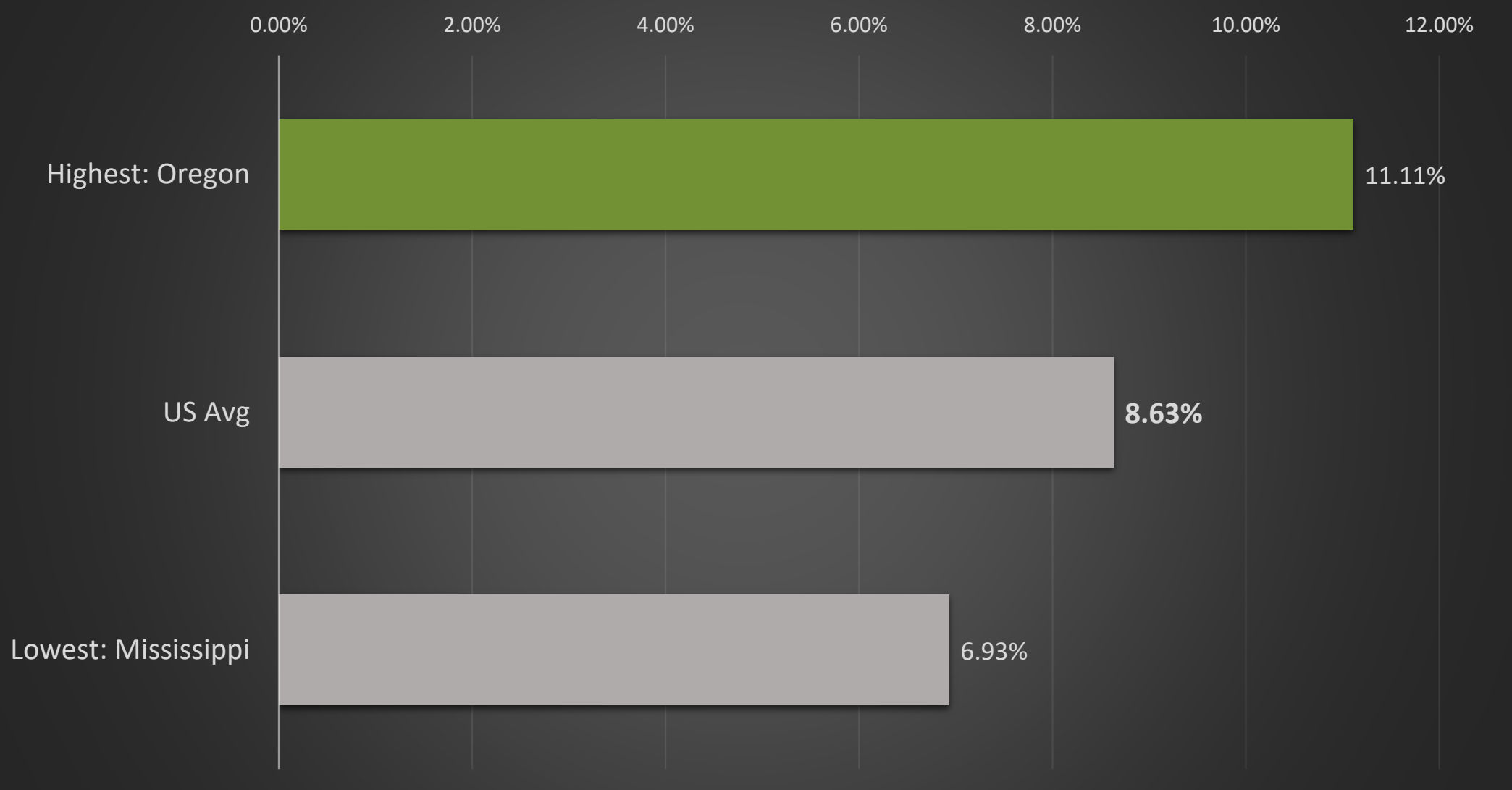


# Major Depressive Episode Past Year,

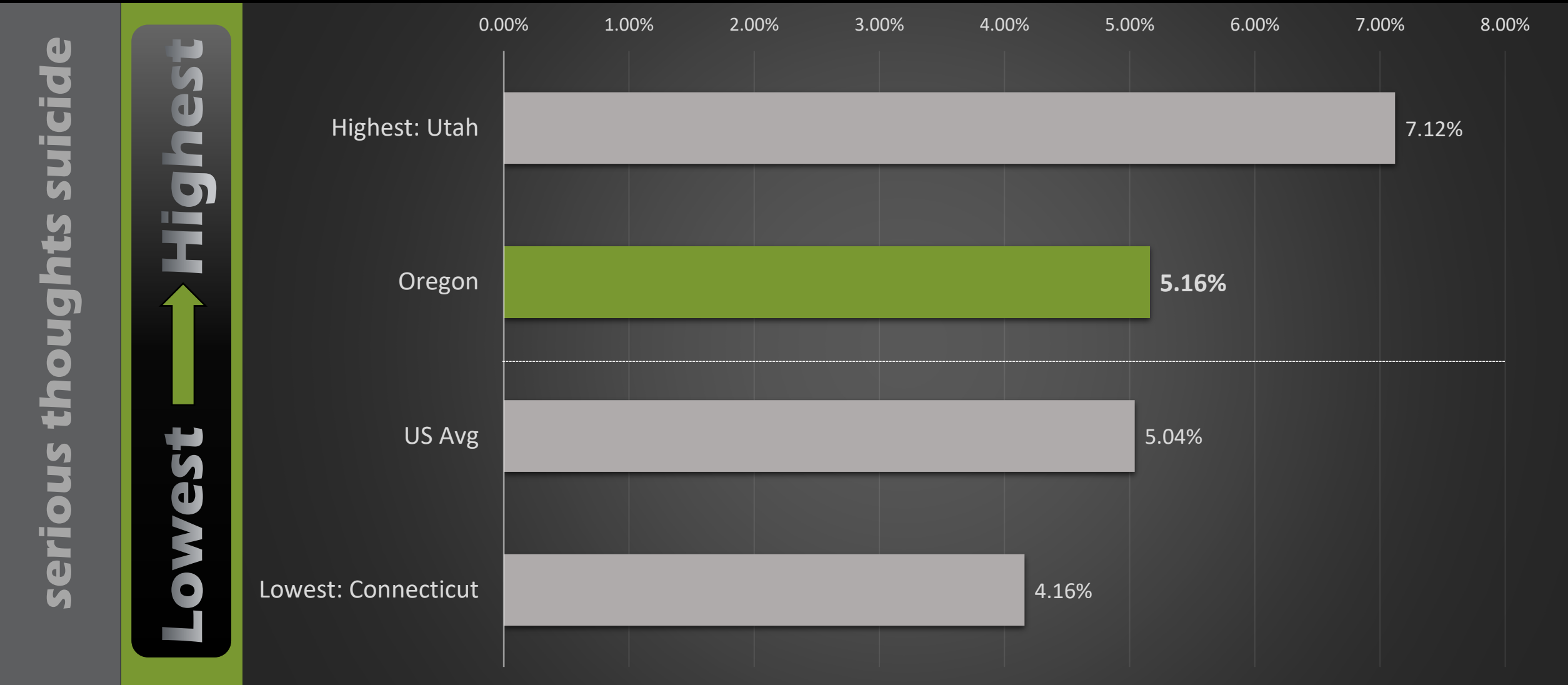

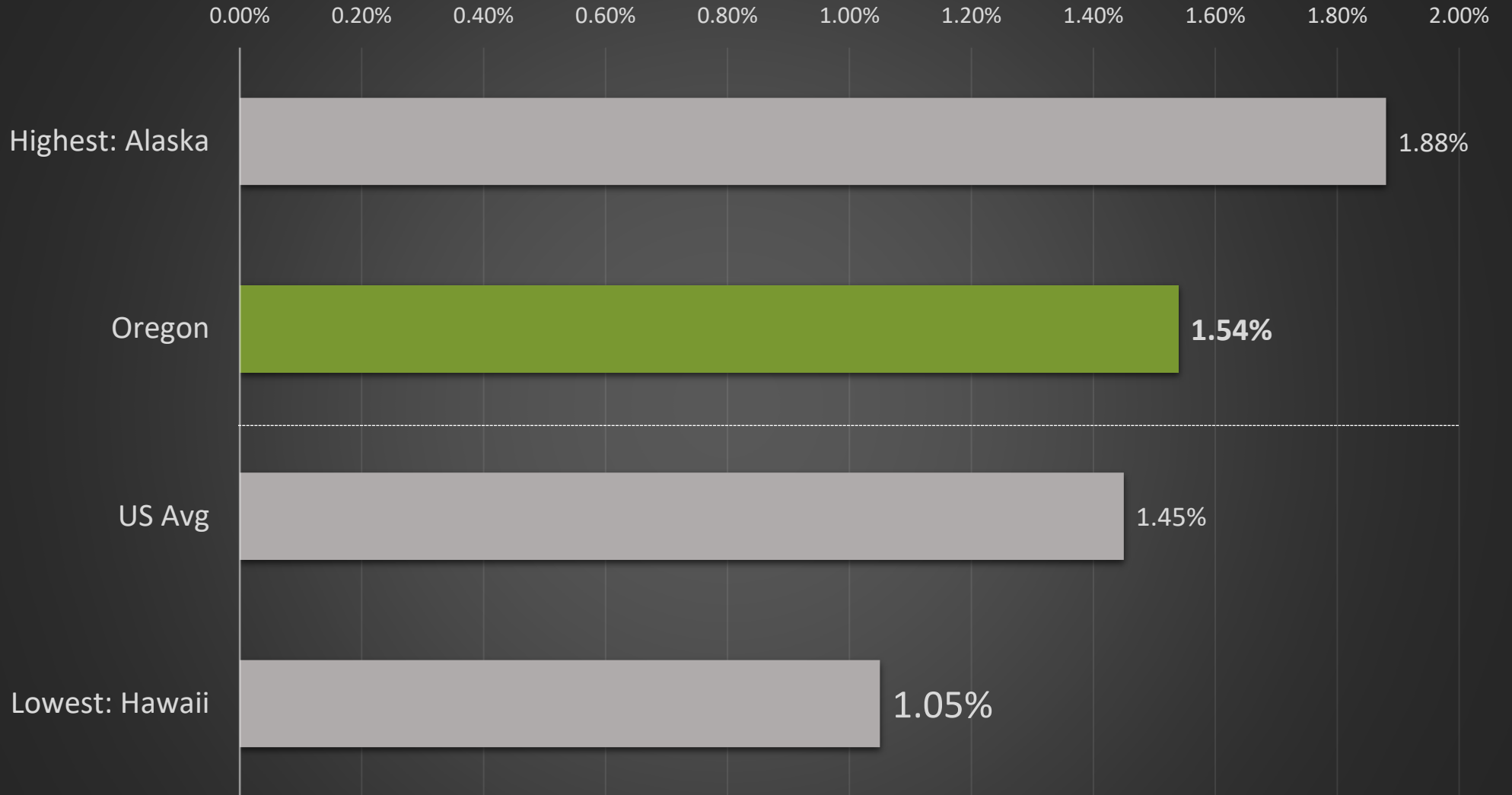


# Made Suicide Plans Past Year,

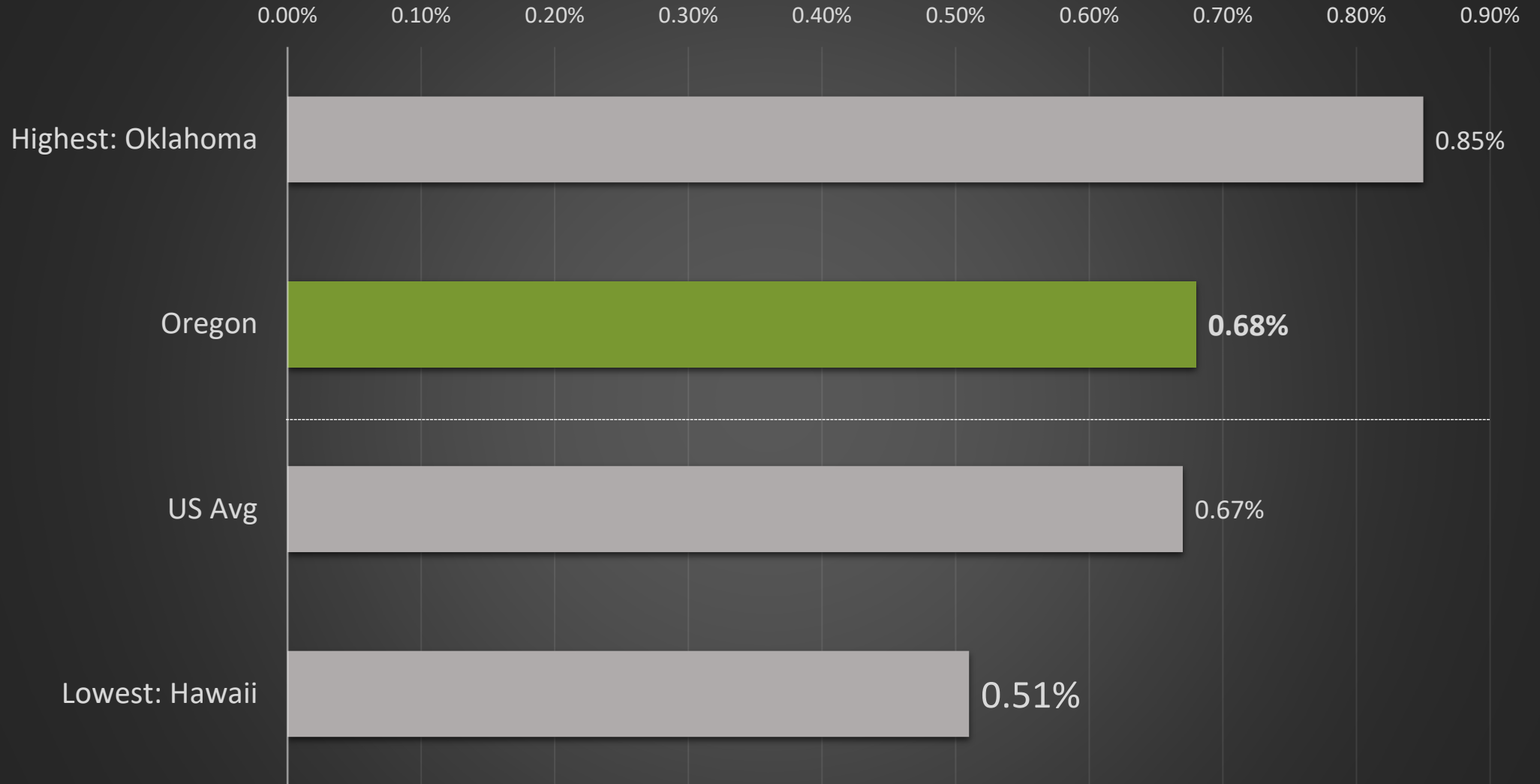


# Attempted Suicide Past Year,

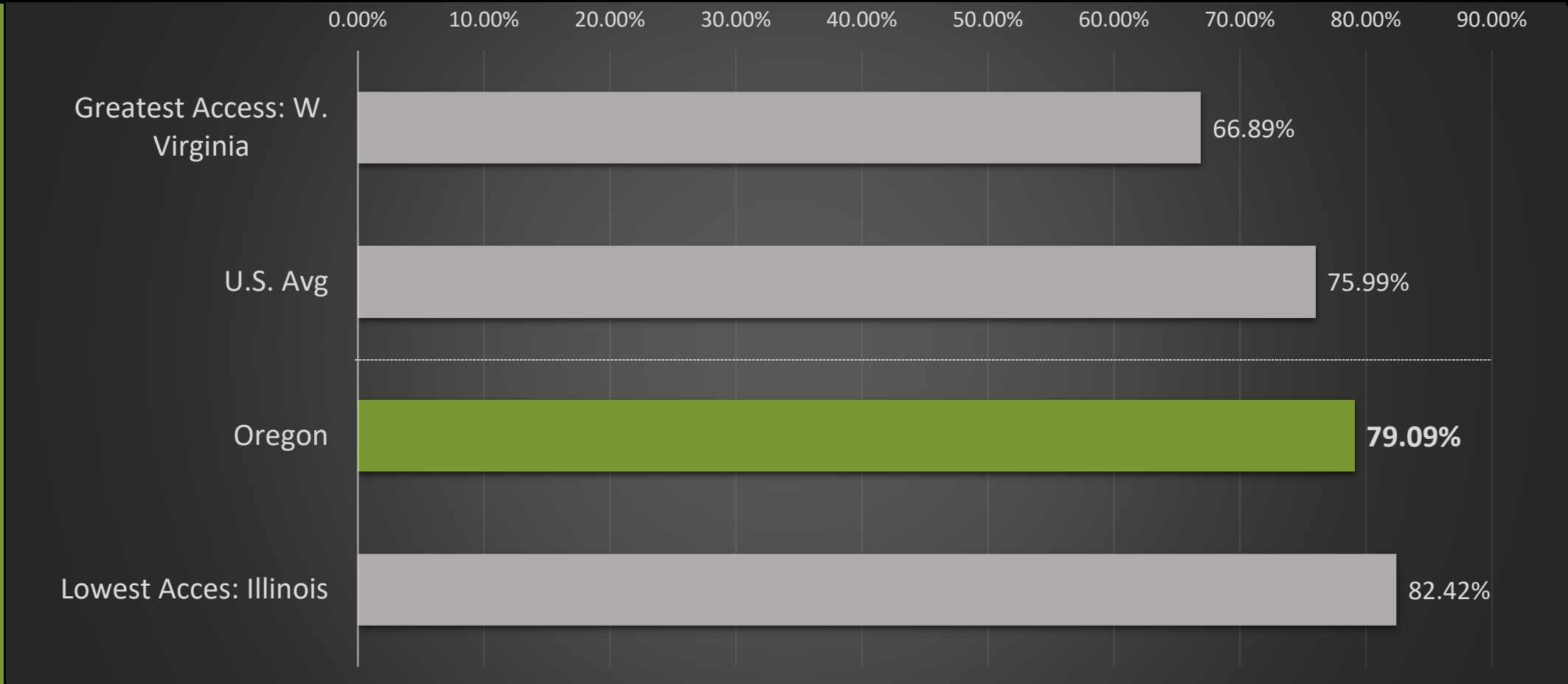


# Needing but not Receiving Treatment for SUDs past year,
